South Pymatuning Township Continuation Meeting

The continuation meeting of the South Pymatuning Township Board of Supervisors was held February 18, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. in the municipal building with Supervisors Laurel Alexander, Chairperson, William Klumph and Matthew Chalupka present. Also present was Mourice Waltz, Zoning Officer and Attorney James Nevant, Solicitor.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the Flag.

Resident Brian Zoccole, 89 Buckeye Drive, Sharpsville, presented comments about his property on Ivanhoe Road and the proposed changes to the property.

A motion by Supervisor Chairperson, Laurel Alexander, to pay \$3,500.00 to Chief of Police, Paul Ferm, IRA for 2019. Supervisor Matthew Chalupka seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairperson, Laurel Alexander, made a motion to hire Burt DeVries at \$25.00 per hour to file delinquent 2019 (March through December) water monthly reports, modify the 2018 Compliance Report, submit the 2019 Compliance Report and perform other duties as necessary. The DEP had contacted the Township regarding the delinquent reports. Supervisor Matthew Chalupka seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Laurel Alexander, Supervisor Chairperson, made a motion to take such action as necessary and proper to place a lien of \$4,800.00 and any relevant costs on the property at 1850 Powers Avenue to pay for demolition of the structure on the property. Supervisor William Klumph seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

After a discussion regarding multiple areas involved for a potential zoning change allowing Event Barns in agricultural zone areas, Chairperson Laurel Alexander made a motion to have the Solicitor and Zoning Officer proceed with the writing of the ordinance to change the zoning. Supervisor Matthew Chalupka seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

There were discussions concerning upgrades to the softball fields and the water grants. There was also discussion of some Township residences in disrepair.

Supervisor Laurel Alexander, Chairperson, made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor William Klumph seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:29 p.m.
